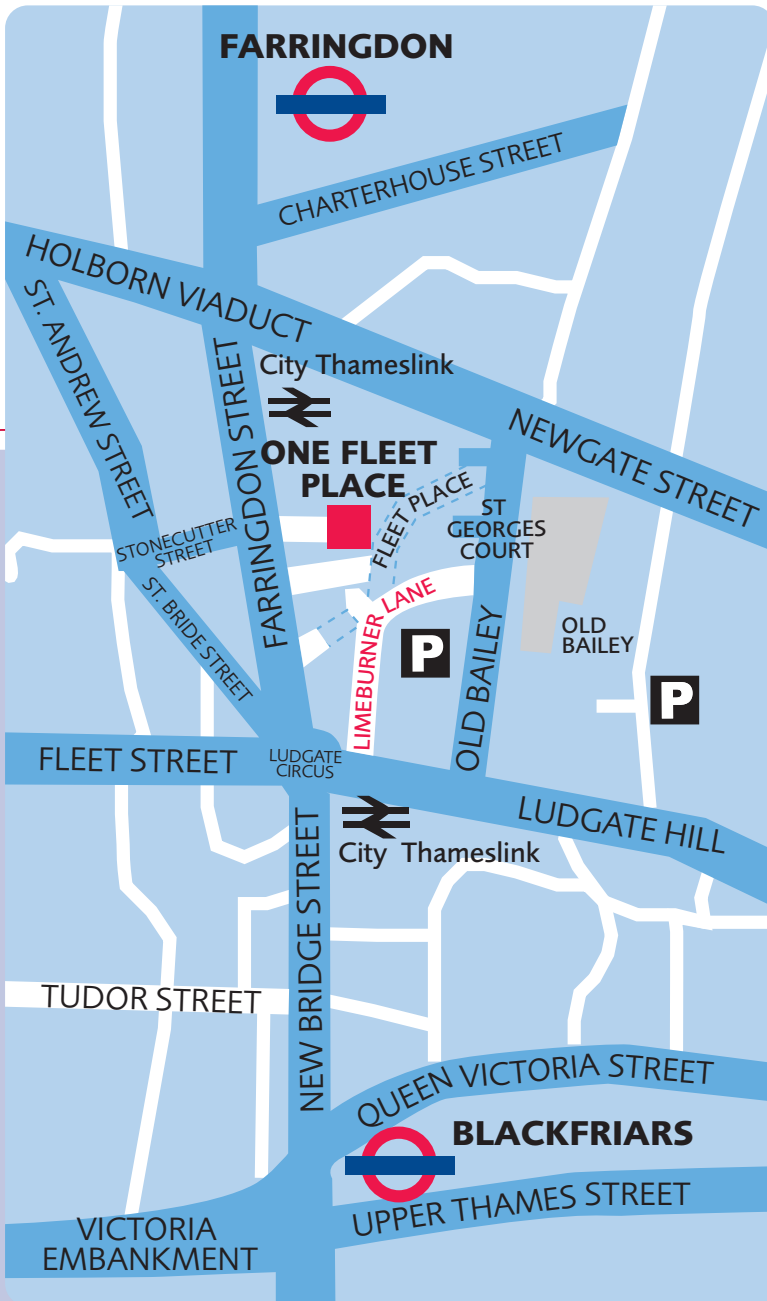

How to get there:

Underground

Blackfriars (District and Circle Lines) is the principal station for Fleet Place and is located just a few minutes' walk away. Leave Blackfriars at Exit 1 (New Bridge Street). Follow New Bridge Street up to Ludgate Circus (away from the river). At Ludgate Circus turn right into Ludgate Hill and then first left into Limeburner Lane. As Limeburner Lane veers to the right, One Fleet Place is ahead and to the left (behind number 10 Fleet Place).

Rail:

Fleet Place is located directly above City Thameslink station (Holborn Viaduct exit).

Car parks:

Public parking is available nearby with an NCP car park located in Limeburner Lane.

Buses:

Ludgate Hill, Holborn Viaduct and Farringdon Street.
