He will be speaking in French on law and literature, evoking such diverse sources as The Ant and the Grasshopper (La Fontaine), The Merchant of Venice, Little Red Riding Hood and Puss in Boots (Tales of Charles Perrault), and on Persians and Orestes by Aeschyles.

The text of Professor Malaurie's talk will be available at the Institute on the day. The talk will be followed by discussion and then dinner in the Bistro of L'Institut Français.
